STANDARD CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER IN ALL CIVIL CASES

- 1. The parties are expected to make full disclosure of their exhibits to one another at least <u>7 days</u> prior to the hearing. Exhibits may be exchanged via email where feasible. Failure to make full disclosure of exhibits may result in their exclusion at hearing.
- 2. The parties are expected to engage in good faith settlement negotiations prior to any hearings in an attempt to resolve their disagreements. The Court will specifically inquire as to any settlement negotiations prior to any hearing.
- 3. The Plaintiff/Petitioner shall mark their exhibits with numbers and the Defendant/Respondent shall mark their exhibits with letters.
- 4. Parties to a case are expected to have three (3) sets of exhibits for hearings and trials: one for the Court, one for the opposing party, and one for the witness stand.
- 5. The sequestration of witnesses is Ordered for all hearings. Witnesses and potential witnesses shall not be present or within earshot for the testimony of other witness, nor shall any witnesses discuss their testimony with other witnesses. Counsel and pro-se parties shall advise their respective witnesses of the sequestration order.
