### VOWELS

VOWELS with NASAL (Ñ)

<b>auñ</b>	<b>NO</b> (not locally)	<b>áuñ</b> (give/gave) <b>dáuñ</b> (opposite gender sibling)
<b>añ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>dáñ</b> (star) <b>áñ:</b> (came/come)
<b>eñ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>déñ</b> (all) <b>éñ:</b> (over here / this)
<b>iñ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>íñ:</b> (over here / this) alternate pronunciation <b>bíñ:gyà</b> (food)
<b>aiñ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>páiñ</b> (dirt) <b>t'aiñ</b> (white)
<b>oñ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>dóñ:gyà</b> (words/language/said) <b>bóñ:</b> (saw/look)
<b>uñ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>gúñ:dàu</b> (tipi pole) <b>gúñ:dé</b> (horn/antler)
<b>uiñ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>gûiñdàu</b> (to be mess up, disheveled, disarrange) <b>màu:gúiñmé</b> (to be useful or beneficial)
<b>oiñ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>sékôiñ</b> (say-koyn) <b>zóiñ</b> (deep)
<b>auíñ</b>	<b>NO</b>	<b>zâuiñ</b> (mash; knead; crush) <b>káuiñ</b> (skin; rind; etc. of fruits, vegetables, etc.)
